Here are some ideas for what other dates to include in your calendar:

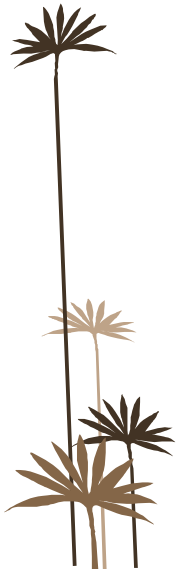
- Birthdays/Anniversaries

Make sure you and your mentor keep a copy of your finished calendar.

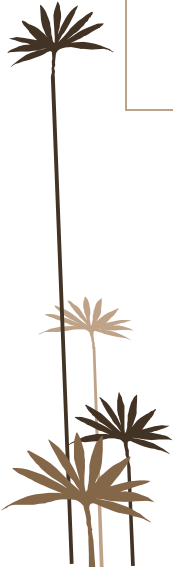
