



Reflecting Christ Through Service, Growth, and Friendship

The Partnering for Eternity program seeks to provide students with opportunities to serve, ease senior isolation, and help with tuition assistance. This program was founded in 2006, inspired by a child who connected with an older adult, creating a lifelong friendship. We are currently partnered with 200 schools across North America who are receiving the rich blessings of PFE.

PFE Statistics

- ~2,000 students participate each year
- Over 1 million hours spent in visitation since 2006
- Over \$15 million in tuition assistance since 2006
- Grades K-8 Earning Potential: ~\$1,320 per year
- Grades 9-12 Earning Potential: \$1,600 per year

Grades K-8 Programming

- Participant slots are based on enrollment
 - Enrollment > 30 = 20% participation (cap of 40)
 - Enrollment < 30 = 50% participation
- Participants are paired with a mentor in the community
 - Non-relative, older adult (55+) or someone with a disability who could use the company or help around the home
- Student visits mentor for one hour, once per week (with parent present)
- Students and mentors form a friendship through shared activities
- Student submits a reflection online during each visit
- Local coordinator reviews reflections weekly for approval
- Scholarship: \$30 per visit
 - 70% funded by SFFC Foundation
 - 30% fundraised by your school community
 - Scholarship sent monthly to school

Grades 9-12 Programming

- Participant slots are capped at 26 per program
- Participants are paired with a mentor in the community
 - Non-relative, older adult (55+) or someone with a disability who could use the company or help around the home
- Student visits mentor for two hours each week
 - Required to visit for 14 weeks each 20-week term
- Student submits a reflection online during each visit
- Must complete all requirements to receive PFE scholarship
- Local coordinator reviews reflections weekly for approval
- Scholarship: \$800 per term
 - 70% funded by SFFC Foundation
 - 30% fundraised by your school community
 - Scholarship sent in January and May
